Using Your UMR ID Card at Retail Pharmacies

Please present your new UMR ID card along with your prescription to any of our 60,000+ retail pharmacies every time you fill your prescription.



Getting a 90-Day Supply of Your **Prescriptions**

If you are prescribed a 90-day prescription for maintenance medications (e.g. long-term conditions like arthritis, asthma, diabetes, high blood pressure or high cholesterol), you can fill your prescription at retail pharmacies or through mail service.

Getting started with Walmart mail service:

Prior to your first fill by mail, please call 1-888-302-2779 and follow the prompts for medications delivered to your home or mail a completed order form to 1025 W. Trinity Mills, Carrollton TX, 75006. This form can be downloaded at www.walmart.com/homedelivery.

Choose one of the following options to submit your prescription:



E-prescribe: Have your doctor e-prescribe to Walmart Pharmacy Mail Order 2625.



Fax: Have your doctor fax your prescription to 1-800-406-8976. Faxed prescriptions may only be sent by a doctor's office and must include patient information and diagnosis for timely processing.



Mail: Mail us your prescription and completed order form to 1025 W. Trinity Mills, Carrollton TX, 75006.

Prior Authorization/Step Therapy/ **Quantity Limit**

In order to ensure safe and appropriate use of certain medications, your prescription benefit program may have prior authorization, step therapy, and/or quantity limits for certain medications.

- Prior authorization requires you and your physician to obtain approval from Capital Rx prior to medication being dispensed.
- Step therapy is when your prescription benefit requires you to try another medication (usually a generic) prior to starting the medication your physician prescribed (usually a brand).
- · Quantity limits only allow you to receive up to a maximum dosage or quantity for certain medications, based on clinically-approved prescribing guidelines.

Call customer service at 1-888-302-2779 to determine if your medication(s) are subject to prior authorization, step therapy, and/or quantity limit requirements.
